CHRISTMAS MESSAGE FROM: ZAMBIA CONFERENCE OF CATHO-LIC BISHOPS' COMMUNICATIONS **SECRETARY** (23rd DECEMBER, 2016)

(Part Two - continues from last week)

Jesus Christ at his birth is proclaimed the King of Peace and Wonderful Counsellor (Isaiah 9:5). This is what we are celebrating at Christmas. However, it is with great regret that Zambia lately has been experiencing situations that do not promote peace. For instance, many persons continue to experience gender related violence. This is despite the main interventions that have been put in place. This is one of the major challenges that is affecting many families. Although indicators from the latest statistics show a marginal reduction, of about 14.5%, compared to the reported cases in 2015, there is no cause for celebration. Our Prayer as Zambia Conference of Catholic Bishops (ZCCB) is to see that the gift of peace that Jesus brought at Christmas permeates all the spheres of human life especially the family. Remember violence in any form, especially physical violence affects not only the persons involved or affected but it affects the country's economy as well There are high costs to be met on medical care for those injured, loss of labour productive hours spent on litigations and so on.

We also want to urge motorists and all other road users to exercise caution during this festive season. The Christian celebration should be that of life- giving and not a time to grieve for the loss of one life due to the recklessness by some drivers on our year to come. roads. Christ came so that our lives can be preserved. "I have come so that they may have life and

have it to the full", Jesus tells us (John 10:10). We hope that the Road Traffic and Safety Agency (RTSA) and the Police will do their best to remove from our roads all those drivers who will be a danger not only to other road users or passengers but to themselves as well.

The rainy season seems to have started at a good note in most part of the country. We hope that the right beneficiaries of the Farmer Input Support Programme (FISP) will receive the right farming inputs and in good time. We therefore urge the government and those responsible officers to deliver all faming input in good time so that the country continues to have sufficient food for our country's food basket. Meanwhile, we urge the people whose livelihood is mainly dependent on fishing in the many water bodies that Zambia is blessed to adhere to the fishing ban as this is for the good of the country and the fu-

In conclusion, as we celebrate Christmas this year, we want to praise God for the gift of his only begotten son. The festive season is also a time for family reunion. It is the time to celebrate together the birth of our Lord Jesus recalling he was born in a family of his mother Mary and Joseph his foster fa-


